Every year The Colorado High School Press Association acknowledges its outstanding newspaper, yearbook and broadcast advisers by selecting one teacher to be CHSPA's Teacher of the Year. Teachers/advisers may be nominated by their principal, a colleague or editor who must write a letter of nomination.

Upon nomination, advisers will receive a questionnaire to complete and return to CHSPA by a designated date. Completed packages (nomination materials and questionnaire) are submitted to a panel of judges.

The following criteria is taken into consideration by judges for deciding a winner:

The adviser must be:

- ◆ An effective educator in the field of journalism and/or publications
- ◆ A quality journalism promoter as shown by participation in state and/or national journalism organizations
- ◆ An adviser whose publications have been recognized by honors and awards given collectively or to individuals on their staff
- ◆ A member of the Colorado High School Press Association

All nominated advisers are recognized at a special ceremony at the adviser award luncheon during Journalism Day at Colorado State University in Fort Collins in October. They receive statewide recognition in *Newsline*, the CHSPA newsletter. The state winner will be submitted to Journalism Education Association for consideration in the JEA outstanding teacher program.
